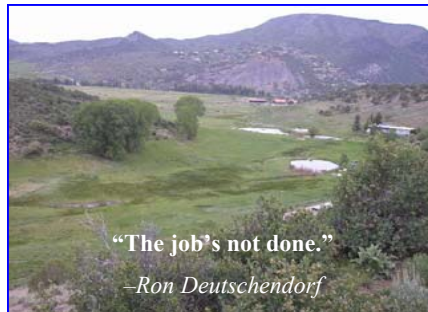

Volunteer Work Weekend

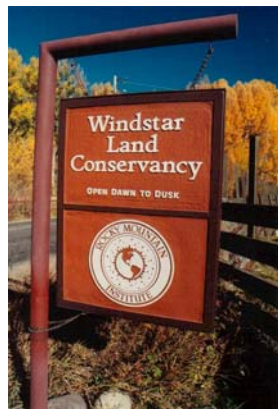
Windstar volunteers from around the world gather to complete tasks designed to beautify, preserve and restore the Windstar Land Conservancy structures and grounds.
